Dragonfly IT accepts no responsibility for any use of the Software that breaches this condition, and you agree to indemnify Dragonfly IT against any claim arising from unauthorised use.

4. What the Software Does

The Software performs a point-in-time discovery scan: it identifies devices responding on the specified subnet, checks a defined list of common network ports for each device, and compiles the results into a PDF report. It does not exploit vulnerabilities, attempt to access systems, capture credentials, or transmit any data off the local machine. All scanning and report generation happens entirely offline, on the device running the Software.

5. No Warranty

The Software is provided "as is", without warranty of any kind, express or implied, including but not limited to fitness for a particular purpose, accuracy, or completeness of results. The Software is a discovery aid, not a certified security audit, and should not be relied upon as the sole basis for security decisions.

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
